Motion to Place Suspended Tariff Records into Effect

Dear Ms. Bose:

Pursuant to Section 4 of the Natural Gas Act (NGA)¹ and Part 154 of the regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission), specifically 18 C.F.R. Section 154.206(b), Florida Gas Transmission Company, LLC (FGT) provides herein a motion to place the tariff records listed in Appendix A to this filing into effect as of August 1, 2021.

STATEMENT OF NATURE, REASONS AND BASIS

On February 1, 2021, FGT filed revised tariff records pursuant to Section 4 of the NGA and Part 154 of the Commission's Regulations in Docket No. RP21-441-000 (Rate Case Filing). FGT proposed rate changes for existing services and changes to certain terms and conditions of service. FGT proposed an effective date of March 1, 2021, for the revised tariff records. In its Order Accepting and Suspending Tariff Records, Subject to Refund, Conditions, and Hearing Procedures issued March 3, 2021 in Docket No. RP21-441-000 (Order)², the Commission accepted and suspended certain tariff records to become effective August 1, 2021, subject to refund, conditions and the outcome of hearing proceedings.

The purpose of this filing is to motion certain tariff records, which are listed on Appendix A hereto, into effect on August 1, 2021. These tariff records are contained in the Rate Case Filing and require no changes.

OTHER FILINGS THAT MAY AFFECT THIS FILING

Concurrent with the instant filing, FGT is filing a separate compliance motion to place revised tariff records into effect on August 1, 2021. The tariff records in the concurrent compliance filing represent those suspended in the Order that have been revised to modify the rates shown therein to reflect a decrease in certain plant costs and to incorporate the intervening

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fuel filings that were made effective subsequent to the Rate Case Filing, as well as to implement the cancellation of Rate Schedule FTS-2.

PROPOSED EFFECTIVE DATE AND MOTION TO PLACE SUSPENDED TARIFF RECORDS INTO EFFECT

Pursuant to Section 4(e) of the NGA and Section 154.206(b) of the Commission's Regulations, FGT hereby moves to place into effect on August 1, 2021, the tariff records listed on Appendix A.

FGT respectfully requests the Commission grant waiver of Section 154.207 of the Commission's Regulations and any other waivers of its Regulations that it deems necessary to allow the proposed tariff records in this filing to become effective on August 1, 2021.

CONTENTS OF THE FILING

This filing is made in electronic format in compliance with Section 154.4 of the Commission's Regulations. The suspended tariff records with metadata attached are submitted as part of an XML filing package containing a transmittal letter to motion the tariff records listed on Appendix A into effect on August 1, 2021.
