Pursuant to Section 4 of the Natural Gas Act (“NGA”)¹ and Part 154 of the regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”), specifically 18 C.F.R. Section 154.206(b), and the March 29, 2023 Order Accepting and Suspending Tariff Records, Subject to Refund, and Establishing Hearing Procedures, Including a Technical Conferenced in Docket No. RP23-466-000 (“Suspension Order”),² Florida Gas Transmission Company, LLC (“Florida Gas”) provides herein its motion to place the tariff records listed below into effect as of August 27, 2023.

STATEMENT OF NATURE, REASONS AND BASIS

On February 27, 2023, Florida Gas Transmission Company, LLC (“Florida Gas”) filed revised tariff records³ pursuant to Section 4 of the NGA and Part 154 of the Commission’s Regulations in Docket No. RP23-466-000 (“February 27 Filing”) to modify the definition and gas quality sections of the General Terms and Conditions (“GT&C”) of its FERC Gas Tariff to define and allow for the receipt and transport of renewable natural gas (“RNG”) on its pipeline system. Florida Gas states the proposed changes will balance the needs of RNG suppliers, the needs of shippers and end-users, the requirement to maintain the safe and efficient operation of its facilities and equipment and the integrity of its system, and the obligation to protect the safety of Florida Gas’ workers. In the Suspension Order, the Commission accepted and suspended Florida Gas’s revised tariff records until August 27, 2023, subject to refund and the outcome of hearing procedures, including a technical conference, established by the Suspension Order.

The purpose of this filing is to motion certain tariff records, which are listed herewith, into effect on August 27, 2023.⁴ These tariff records are contained in the February 27 Filing and require no changes.
