Dear Ms. Bose:

On April 5, 2018, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission” or “FERC”), issued an Order Issuing Certificate (“Order”) in the above referenced proceeding granting Florida Gas Transmission Company, LLC (“FGT”) authorization under Section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act and Part 157 of the Commission’s regulations, to construct and operate: (i) 13.17 miles of 12-inch-diameter pipeline and a meter station in Matagorda and Wharton Counties, Texas; (ii) 11.01 miles of 16-inch-diameter pipeline and a meter station in Jefferson County, Texas; (iii) 0.5 miles of pipeline and a meter station in Acadia Parish, Louisiana; (iv) a meter station in Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana; and (v) to modify station piping at Compressor Station 6 in Orange County, Texas (“East - West Project” or “Project”), as more fully described in the application and as conditioned in the body and Appendix of such Order. On April 10, 2018, FGT accepted the certificate in the above referenced docket.

On November 21, 2018, FGT filed its *Request for Authorization to Place Specific Project Facilities In-Service – Phase I* on or before November 30, 2018, upon mechanical completion of the first phase of the authorized project facilities identified therein. Due to delays in the field, FGT supplemented its November 21, 2018 filing on December 14, 2018 and filed its *Supplement to Request for Authorization – Phase I Facilities*, requesting written authorization from the Director of OEP to place the first phase of the authorized East - West Project facilities in-service by December 17, 2018 in order to commence service to the Shipper on December 18, 2018. On December 14, 2018, the Commission issued a Letter Order granting *Authorization to Place Specific Project Facilities In-Service*. In compliance with Ordering Paragraph (B) of the Order, pursuant to the Commission’s Regulations under Section 157.20(c)(2), and in accordance with the Commission’s December 14, 2018 Letter Order granting authorization to commence partial in-service, FGT hereby notifies the Commission that the **Phase I Facilities** of the East - West Project were placed in-service on **December 18, 2018**.

FGT will comply with all remaining terms and conditions of the Order, and provide a copy of this filing directly to FERC – OEP Staff. Any questions concerning this filing maybe addressed to the undersigned at (713) 989-2605.
